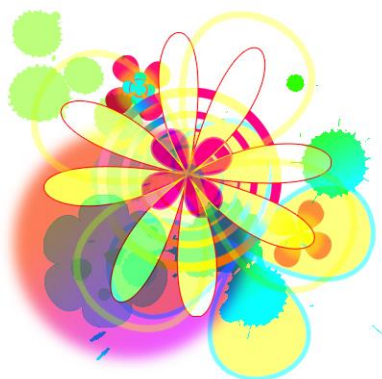

### NEWS FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE



#### Medications in the health office:

If your child has any medications at school it is VERY IMPORTANT that you pick them up no later than May 24th. We cannot send medications home with your son/daughter. ALL medications left at the school after May 25th will be disposed of. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Remember SAFETY as we head into the warmer months of summer!

~Be safe around the water. Swim only with adults present and know your limitations!

As a reminder current 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will need a Tdap vaccination before entering the 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Parents can contact the Mesa County Health Dept. (248-6900) to schedule an appointment or contact your family health care provider. Please bring a current copy of the immunization record to the health assistant after vaccines have been updated.

Reminder: If your student will need medications for the next school year all paperwork must be completed before the start of the school year. All medications must be brought to the health office by parents.
