

Families, we love being able to have you on campus again! It is a great opportunity for us to meet/see you each day. It is also a fun opportunity for us to socialize a bit each day!

It does post some concerns however, when it comes to our pick-up process. Our number one concern is about student and family safety. We are asking for your help in this process by adhering to a few minor changes. Please take a look at our parking lot map and the bulleted guidelines below.



- Please meet your students in their designated area in front of the school. We realize that several of you meet your students behind the school or in the field, but this makes it difficult for teachers to keep track of all students. We will have signs on Monday for designated areas.
- We would also ask you to stay back just a bit so that teachers can have a direct line of sight as their students are getting into vehicles and meeting up with siblings or parents.
- Please stay in your vehicle if you are in the pick up loop (blue arrows). This allows traffic to keep moving. We are happy to walk your children to your car.
- You are more than welcome to park in the parking lot and walk to pick up your student, but please keep the pick up loop moving by remaining in your vehicle.
- Please pull all the way up in the loop so that we do not have vehicles backed up onto Broadway
- Our crosswalk is new this year (in RED). PLEASE PLEASE use it. We realize that it is more convenient to walk through the pick up loop and parking lot, but it poses a significant safety issue when cars on the inside loop (green arrows) are trying to exit the parking lot.
- We will be out front on Monday to help remind students and families of these new, minor changes to our pick-up procedure.
